# Our History

The birth of aviation in the Sultanate was marked by the government's early effort to provide medical services to rural areas. The World Wide Helicopter Company was contracted to fly doctors to locations inaccessible by road.

In 1966, three Royal Air Force (RAF) pilots from Great Britain took over the role signifying the birth of the air force. The following year, Lt Ak Abidin bin Pg Ahmad and Lt Jocklin bin Kungpaw became the first two local pilots to undergo basic flying training in the United Kingdom.

Over the years, the organisation grew with the introduction of various aircrafts and assets.

Today, the RBAirF continues to be Brunei Darussalam's premier aviation entity, undertaking its roles in defending and providing service to the Nation.

# Our Logo

**Crown** symbolises an organisation bestowed with the title “Royal”. It also signifies the organisation’s loyalty to the Sultan and nation.

**Crescent** symbolises Islam, the official state religion. It emphasises the RBAirF’s duty and responsibility in upholding the Malay Islamic Monarchy concept. Within the crescent, the term “Berbakti Di Angkasa” or “To Serve In The Skies” is written in jawi, as a motto for our organisation in preserving the nation’s interest through the air.

**Keris** represents the traditional Malay weapon. It also symbolises our duty in defending and preserving the nation’s interests.

**Wings** symbolises an organisation serving in the skies.




**Wings & Keris** symbolises the Air Force.

# Career Development

Career Development for our personnel are managed through established Career Development Bodies.

To progress through the ranks, our officers and personnel must attend mandatory courses and complete their annual military fitness tests. Other factors include work performance and contributions.

Additionally, officers are required to attend and pass promotion exams, which are only eligible for those who get through Basic Qualifying Tests.

# Primary, Additional and Secondary Tasks

As service personnel, your spouse or family member will be given a variety of roles and responsibilities.

## **Primary**

Duties that are in line with their job specification. These duties reflect their day-to-day roles.

## **Additional**

Duties that complement their job specification. Eg. Extra appointments to supplement the functioning of their squadron.

## **Secondary**

Duties that fall out of their job specification. Eg. Team manager for the RBAirF sports team.



# SPOUSE RESOURCE

# Protocol

Throughout your spouse's career, you will be invited to attend various ceremonies and events. These ceremonies and events will entail an understanding of protocols. Knowing the protocol can help you feel comfortable and confident during your attendance.

## National Anthem

When the National Anthem is announced: **stand, and sing along if appropriate.**

**Don't talk, eat, or distract from the performance of the National Anthem.**

## Seating

During certain events, you will be required to sit according to a prearranged seating arrangement. The seating plan will be provided before the event.

## Colours ("Panji-Panji")

When the colours are marched on and off parade, you will be required to stand.

## Proper Etiquette to Addressing

When addressing others, it is customary to address them based on their ranks and titles.

## In the Presence of Royalty

Avoid wearing Yellow coloured clothing.

Speak using the correct *terasul* (see next page). When in doubt, you can speak in English and address the Royal Delegation as "Your Majesty" or "Your Highness".

## ***Terasul***

When speaking with royalty, it is customary to apply the proper *terasul*.

# Mess Etiquette

Mess Dinners Nights are held to celebrate the Dining-In of new mess members, Dining-Out of outgoing members and to celebrate important occasions in a regimental setting.


## Behaviour at the Mess Table

The dinner is a formal function, as such, special rules are observed:

- Diners may not commence a meal before the top table has been served and started their meal.
- Diners may not talk after the PMC summons attention until he has finished speaking.
- Diners may not leave the table during the meal unless permitted to do so by the PMC.

# RBAF Wives Welfare Body

The RBAirF Wives Welfare Body (BAKTI TUDB), as a chapter within the RBAF Wives Welfare Body or *Badan Kebajikan Isteri-Isteri ABDB* (BAKTI), is an organisation comprising wives of RBAirF officers and warrant officers. It is headed by the Spouse of the Commander of the RBAirF, with the Commander of the RBAirF in an advisory role for BAKTI TUDB.

BAKTI functions to provide support, welfare and social activities for the female RBAF spouses and their families. Commonly seen as a way to offer friendship, even kinship, amongst the female spouses, and further strengthen the sisterhood bond within the military community, a BAKTI member is to benefit from engaging in its various initiatives, events, and activities, such as educational programs, health and wellness initiatives, community outreach, social gatherings and charity work.

Once a male RBAirF officer marries, his spouse becomes a member of BAKTI TUDB. As a male RBAirF senior non-commissioned officer gets promoted to the post of Drill Sergeant Major (DSM) (and above), his spouse becomes a BAKTI TUDB member as well.

# RBAirF Messes and Corporal Club

## **Mess**

The Mess represents a regimental environment for members to gather and socialise. It is managed by a Mess Committee headed by a President (President of the Mess Committee - PMC). The committee will regularly host activities to promote camaraderie and esprit de corps amongst members. The RBAirF includes various Mess Committees; Officers Mess (for Officers at all levels), and Warrant Officers, Staff Sergeants and Sergeants Mess (for members from the rank of Sergeant up to Warrant Officer).

## **Mess Bill**

To ensure the upkeep of the Mess, members must pay monthly fees for various funds such as Welfare, Entertainment and Sports.

## **Corporal Club**

The Corporal Club functions similarly to the Mess. Members consist of airmen and airwomen up to the rank of Corporal.

## **Corporal Club Fund**

Unlike the Mess Bill, Corporal Club members are only required to pay an annual fee.


- National events such as when Brunei Darussalam hosts the ASEAN Summit

# Operational Security

Operations Security (OPSEC) means safeguarding sensitive information from others. Today, the greatest threat to OPSEC is information shared online, particularly via **social media**.

Refrain from sharing the following:

- Information about your spouse or family member's job, mission or assigned task.
- Specific dates and locations of deployments.
- Information about unit morale or equipment.
- Schedules or itineraries.
- Images that portray the organisation negatively.



# Military Time

Military time is a method of measuring the time based on the full twenty-four hours of the day rather than two groups of twelve hours.

Using military time simply omits the need to use AM and PM and avoids any confusion on which half of the day you are referencing. Just like a 12-hour digital clock, military time is always displayed in four digits. The first two digits represent the hour and the last two digits represent the minutes.
